



PRIVACY POLICY

The Privacy Policy below describes how NSE collects, retains and uses your personal data in accordance with the requirements of the European Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The concept of "Personal Data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, directly or indirectly, by reference to an identification number or to one or more elements specific to it.

This policy is intended to inform you:

- the means we use to collect your personal data, in the strictest respect of your rights,
- on the data likely to be collected on our Site,
- the use that can be made of the data collected and the rights you have on these data.

NSE is committed to:

- ensure compliance with the principles on the protection of personal data,
- inform people about the existence of their rights of access, rectification and object,
- carry out the completion of legal and / or regulatory formalities.

We inform you that we comply, in the collection and management of your personal data, with the law n ° 78-17 of January 6th, 1978 relative to the computing, the files and freedoms, modified and in its version and the General Data Protection Regulation, adopted on 27 April 2016 by the European Parliament, and the relevant laws and regulations.

Data Management

What data do we collect and for what purposes ?

When you visit our website, you can share your personal data with NSE who operates as Data Processing Manager. These data are used by NSE for the following purposes:

- Manage subscriptions and unsubscriptions to newsletters (collecting your email address only)
- Manage your requests for right of access, rectification, object of your data
- Process your requests and answer your messages
- Process your applications, to study them and to be able to contact you. If you use the online form, we collect your CV, cover letter and your email address
- Measure the audience of our site via non-nominal data

Our goals are determined, legitimate and explicit. They are compatible with our missions. Data collected for a specific purpose is not used for other purposes.

How long are the data kept?

The data are only kept for strictly necessary periods. The general data retention policy of NSE is as follows:

- Newsletters contact details: until unsubscription
- Application Data: 6 months
- Navigation data (non-nominal): 2 years after the date of last activity on the site.

Data Subject Rights

In accordance with the law n ° 78-17 of January 6, 1978 "computer and liberties" as well as the provisions of the General Regulations on the Protection of Data, adopted on April 27, 2016 by the European Parliament, you have a right to access, rectification, deletion, portability and object to the processing of your personal information. You also have the possibility to oppose the treatment for prospecting purposes, especially commercial.

Right to object:

You can exercise your right to object in the following ways:

- For newsletters: by clicking on the unsubscribe link mentioned in the newsletters addressed to you
- For navigation data: refer to the paragraph of cookies available in the Cookie Management section of this chart.

For all these requests, and for security purposes, we thank you for sending a postal mail or an e-mail, signed by the applicant and accompanied by a proof of identity (national Identity card) or passport) bearing the signature of the person who exercises his right.

We will indicate the measures taken as soon as possible and, at the latest, one month after receipt of the request. This period can be extended to two additional months if necessary, because of the complexity and the number of requests. We will inform you of this delay within one month from the receipt of your request, indicating the reasons for the delay.

Data recipient

The personal data collected about you is intended for NSE. In order to carry out the treatments listed above, only the persons processing the data or the duly authorized recipients can access, within the framework of a security policy making it possible, in particular, to manage access to the only information necessary for the activity. Indeed, NSE defines the rules of access and confidentiality applicable to the personal data processed. Access rights are granted in accordance with the user's function and are updated in case of change or change of function.

The data we are collecting about you are not intended to be transferred outside the European Union. However, if this should be the case, we guarantee, in case of transfer of your data abroad and especially outside the European Union, to implement all the appropriate measures to guarantee a sufficient level of protection of your data, as :

- Move towards so-called "safe" countries, that is to say offering an important protection of your data;
- Request the necessary authorizations from the Supervisory Authority before any data collection if required by the country;
- Obtain guarantees of security and confidentiality from subcontractors, for example, by imposing contractual clauses, reserving the possibility to control them regularly and by conducting audits.

Data security

NSE has put in place reasonable technical and organizational security measures to protect your personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure, unauthorized access and other illicit forms or unauthorized treatment, in accordance with the applicable legislation.

The management of cookies

We wish to place a cookie on your computer. a cookie does not allow us to identify you. However, it records information about the navigation of your computer on our site (the pages you have visited, the date and time of consultation, etc.) that we can read during your subsequent visits. The shelf life of this information in your computer is equal to 2 years. We inform you that you can oppose the registration of "cookies" by configuring your browser as follows:
